Goals:

- **To develop new and enhance existing CTE Pathway Programs of Study at the high school, Adult Ed. and GCCCD levels that meet program criteria and regional labor market needs.**
- **To develop a clear and meaningful articulation/alignment plan for the CTE Pathways Program at GUHSD high schools, Adult Ed., Grossmont and Cuyamaca Colleges to:**
 - **increase numbers of students completing CTE Pathways;**
 - **receiving college credit on transcripts;**
 - **and transitioning successfully to postsecondary options and the workplace**
- **Develop Work Readiness Curriculum with options for all levels**
- **Collaborate on Workforce Engagement Events**

Positive Outcomes

- ★ **Strong relationships across systems**
- ★ **Strengthened articulation/alignment process**
 - ★ **2017/18 = 320 students, 2018/19 = 534 students**
- ★ **Clear connections for students - they are familiar with CC campuses and programs**
 - ★ **23% increase in college enrollment in 2019**
- ★ **Work Based Learning collaboration**
 - ★ **30% increase in degree and/or certificate completion in 2018**
- ★ **Student engagement activities**
 - ★ **College and Career Fair Contacts in 2019 = 1,177**

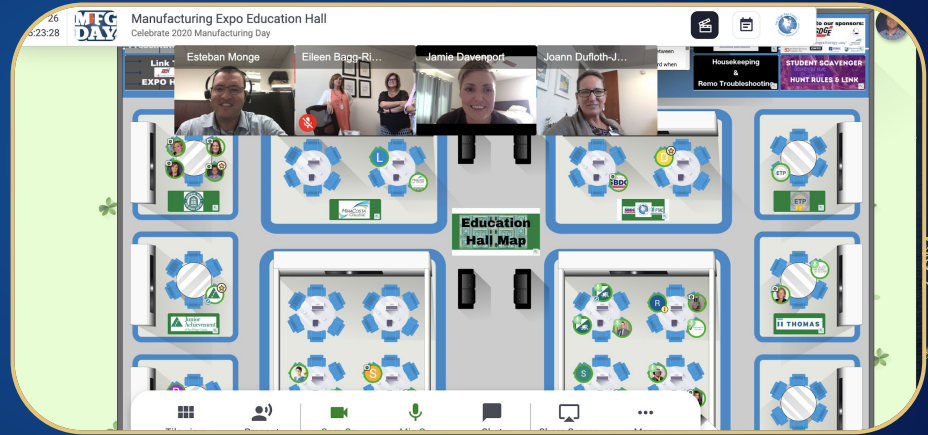
