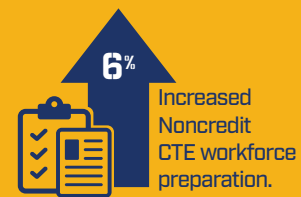
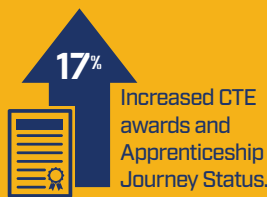


REALIZE POSITIVE OUTCOMES THROUGH THE STRONG WORKFORCE PROGRAM

LEVERAGING RESOURCES

Regional Partnerships

Collaborate with regional Economic Development Corporations (EDC), Local Education Agencies, Offices of Education for San Diego and Imperial Counties, and adult education schools to inform and improve educational pathways to higher education, and provide internships and employment opportunities for students.

Employer Engagement

Facilitate college connections with employers to ensure curriculum alignment with industry needs, create work-based learning experiences, and expand employment opportunities.

Investments in Colleges

Invest strategically in the colleges to support projects that address the needs of industry and achieve the goals of the Regional Priorities. For example, our partnership with the San Diego Regional EDC and the Advancing San Diego grant provided paid internships to students.
