

Dates	Activities
Feb-Mar 2021	Region votes on industry & occupational metrics
Mar 2021	COE conducts analysis basis on metrics selected by the region
Apr 2021	COE presents the analysis to the region (e.g., WDC, ROC) for feedback
Apr-May 2021	COE revises analysis based on feedback
May 2021	COE presents to the region again
June 2021	COE finalizes analysis
