The Work-Based Learning Professional Development Course is a self-paced, asynchronous training for college faculty offered via Canvas beginning October 1, 2021. The curriculum is intended to increase awareness and understanding of the WBL continuum, equity in WBL, the MIS SG21 data points, and how to incorporate work-based learning into the classroom.

These modules will cover the following course learning outcomes:

- Understand the benefits and importance of incorporating work-based learning into your courses
- Design a lesson that integrates work-based learning experiences into your course

Course Duration:

This course is intended to take approximately 20 hours for content completion and is best taken with a partner for reflection and peer review exercises. There is an optional additional 10 hours of course content available. The course must be completed in 45 days or by December 3, 2021.
