Approved Resolution for Restorative Justice SDICCCA Board Meeting - March 20, 2017

In order to facilitate the successful navigation of formerly incarcerated students through the admissions, registration, financial aid and other

processes at the community college near their place of residence, it is resolved to provide a transitional services program for formerly incarcerated students with effective on-ramps to assist them in obtaining the resources and support services needed to achieve their academic and career goals. In order to institutionalize and ensure sustainability, it is further resolved that the transitional services program for formerly incarcerated students will be placed under the leadership of CSSOs at each SDICCCA community college. CSSOs will meet quarterly to discuss regional issues pertaining to the transitional services program.
