## Meeting Topics:

- Suzanne Sebring and Heather Cavazos from the San Diego and Imperial Counties Community Colleges Regional Consortium attended the meeting to present their vision for adding a Rising Scholars workgroup in the Career Pathways regional work. A graphic representation of the Career Pathways regional work was shared with the group, along with an overview of the work being done at the regional level. Suzanne asked the group if they were interested in partnering with the region on a project to identify industry partners that are willing to offer work experience and jobs to our students. The group indicated overall interest in pursuing this and decided to dedicate the first 30 minutes of each monthly meeting to moving this work forward. Suzanne will create a Google Drive document that members can update with known resources. The drive will also hold the Career Pathways graphic and Suzanne/Heather will work on compiling a one sheet that members can share with their districts to explain the mission and ask. - Laura Pecenco just started working on Guided Pathways at Miramar. She asked if any other colleges were using Guided Pathways funding for Rising Scholars Programs. Suzanne mentioned that Palomar had included Transitions students on the Guided Pathways planning team.
- A conversation about student engagement occurred. Octavio mentioned he's concerned when students are not responsive. Raquel mentioned she's been contacting students on a weekly basis at Southwestern. Nora mentioned multiple check in times and options are available for students at Palomar. These take place through Canvas, Zoom, phone calls, and social media platforms.
