- 6. SD County of Education Collaboration: A. Love and M. deRuyter engaged the group in a discussion about how the K12s and community colleges can collaborate in their efforts to increase enrollment into postsecondary education. Ideas included sharing of data, increasing dual enrollment, and improving counselor training. The feedback will be shared with the Career Pathways workgroup. - 7. Roadmap Talking Points Feedback: D. Brown shared the updated talking points that are associated with the new Student's Road to Career Success. If anyone has any edits or feedback, send them to D. Brown directly.
- 8. SG21 Glossary/Framework/Inventory Update: K. McMackin presented the <u>summary of 2021</u> Changes to the WBL Glossary. A sub-committee consisting of the Regional Chair, Workgroup 4 Chairs, Data and Research Workgroup representative, and two WBL Practitioners reviewed and approved the changes to the WBL Glossary.
- 9. WDC Voting Membership: D. Brown reminded the group that the current WDC membership consists of the designated career education deans and Regional Directors. She highlighted that when funding for the Regional Directors ends in December, the voting structure will be the same as it currently is for Deans' Council. She suggested that the membership be re-evaluated to include participation from a wider variety of stakeholders. This agenda item will be brought back to a future meeting.
