- 4. Employer Relations Liaisons Update
  - K. McMackin shared the <u>bios</u> for the seven Employer Relations Consultants (ERLs) that have been hired so far to support Cuyamaca (Monica Rosas), Grossmont (Jenny Preciado), MiraCosta (Lynn Bigsby), SDCCE (Rachel Sanchez), Mesa (Erica Olmos), Miramar (Lance Grob) and Southwestern (Vanessa Barron). Hiring for Imperial Valley, City, and Palomar will be revisited this summer.
- 5. ACUE Pilot for Faculty Institute Completers
  - T. Ngo Bartel presented on the ACUE pilot, which is the next step for the Faculty Institute completers. The pilot will provide completers with this additional professional learning opportunity aimed at further increasing student persistence and retention. The training will be provide by ACUE and will be paid for by the region. In September, three completers form each college will be invited to apply. The training will begin in October.
- 6. SG-21 Workshops
