# Why a Regional Approach?

- Reduce risk of experimentation and missteps

# Regional CPL Workgroup Objectives

## Develop regional support for local CPL development

- Ensure our students have similar experiences at each campus

## Identify resources for colleges implementing CPL

- Regional repository of resources
- Information for students & partners on careered.org
- Databases (CPL approved courses, industry certifications, military articulations)
- Potential RFAs to support design & implementation

## Provide professional development

- Understanding your CPL Policies and Procedures
- Faculty, Counselors, A&R/Evaluations Staff, Articulation Officers, Regional Directors, Administrators, etc.

# Progress Update

- Faculty lead at each college (in place)
- Professional Development
  - Fall 2021: Introductory trainings
  - Spring 2022: Specialized workshops
    - Student Services/Records
    - Counseling for CPL
    - Articulation
  - Train the Trainer series to be piloted by CPL leads in early fall
    - Will be available to whole system through Vision Resource Center (VRC)
- Need: Strategic planning for implementation of CPL at each campus

# Ongoing and Future Goals

- Aligned policies and procedures
- Aligned petition process for students
- Regional collaboration of discipline faculty
- Centralized database
- Regional marketing strategy

Future funding possibilities to continue the work: CCCCO, IEPI, RSWP, etc.
