Minutes

- 1. Welcome and introductions
- 2. Approve Minutes from 11-30-22
 - Motion to approve by B. Houser, second by S. Cooke, abstentions by C. Sharp and S. Topham, unanimously approved.
- 3. Regional Black CE Student Equity Project: B. Gamboa shared an update on the Regional Black CE Student Equity Project. As a reminder, the goal of the project was to:
 - Focus on black student equity
 - Engage in a full research study
 - Identify strategies to support colleges in closing gaps
 - Integrate findings across regional investments

The initial emerging needs from the research include:

- Need for inclusive & anti-racist learning environments
- Need for flexible course schedules for adult learners
- Need for transformative employment opportunities

Next Steps include:

- Finalize the report & recommendations
- Share through governance groups: deans, WDC & ROC
- Embed throughout projects & funding opportunities
- 4. Center of Excellence (COE) Update: T. Ngo Bartel shared the following updates:
 - Counselor Institute
 - To receive a \$2,000 stipend, counselors will complete the following activities with their college cohort:
 - Complete a regional assignment with reflection questions

- Participate in monthly check-in meetings
- Attend two regional professional learning events (kickoff & wrap-up)
- Regional Assignment Sections include:
 - Examining course data
 - Exploring student interest & career aspirations
 - Managing workflows in your day-to-day work
 - Developing cross-campus relationships
- o Timeline:
 - Create regional assignment in Canvas with advisory group: Jun Feb
 - Release RFA & complete consultation meetings: Mar Apr
 - Counselors sign up with Career Education Deans for the Institute: Apr Sep
 - Host kickoff event Oct 6 or Sep 29 Host wrap-up event: May 2024
- ACUE: Inclusive Teaching for Equitable Learning (ITEL): The regional consortium funded
 30 faculty to obtain the following microcredential.
 - Five modules:
 - 1. Managing the Impact of Biases
 - 2. Reducing Microaggressions in Learning Environments
 - 3. Addressing Imposter Phenomenon and Stereotype Threat
 - 4. Creating Inclusive Learning Environments
 - 5. Designing Equity-Centered Courses
 - Over sixty people applied, but only 14 completed. The second cohort will be held Feb 27- Apr 23, 2023. Interested faculty should contact Robert Chu <u>rchu@miracosta.edu</u>
