

Health Care Workforce Partnership Updates	Karen Connelly : Karen to maybe able to provide assistance with employer letters. City with seeking letters from employers in regarding wages. Local regional report states that the workforce needs to double.



HCAI Wellness Coach	Ben Gamache: Provided an overview of the HCAI Wellness Coach Certification and how it came to be. HCAI's goal is health equity. Children and Youth Behavioral Health Initiative (CYBHI) invested \$38 million with HCAI to build the Wellness Coach (Children & Youth 0 to 25 yrs) over all capacity of the workforce. Diverse workforce. Close the gap between. Employed primarily in schools and community-based organizations. Filling in workforce gaps. The role of the Wellness Coach is to increase the capacity of the behavioral health workforce. Serve vulnerable population where they live, study, and work. The goal is to make the certification desirable enough so people stay in the workforce and have a pathway to licensure. Working with DHCS for the Wellness Coach to be reimbursable by private insurance and Medi-Cal. The role is to be supportive and collaborative role within the care team for the individuals they serve. HCAI has "gap funding" to support the individuals and employers to build the workforce.
Connie La Fuente	Recommended getting letters of support from employers. UC San Marcos has reached out to Connie to form a partnership on their Wellness Coach II degree.
