- M. Omae, Dean, Behavioral and Social Sciences, and Consumer and Family Studies, San Diego City College attended the meeting to gain clarification on the RERP Social Work Grant, Social Work Certificate of Achievement. As a reminder, City College had previously submitted their CoA and it was not recommended by the Deans' Council. Discussion included the following:
 - City College submitted the program as Social Work so as not to confuse with the already approved Social Work program that is being offered at college. These concerns were discussed and addressed.
 - o In regards to the concerns over low earnings, City College will include letters from employers that have employed current students who are pursuing certificate or an Associate Degree
 - These discussion points will aid in the alignment of social work curriculum across the six participating colleges

 - Requires at least high school diploma but less than a bachelor's degree
 - Has 50 annual job openings or more in San Diego County
 - Pays at or above the living wage of \$18.43/hr for a single adult
 - Typically requires fewer than 5 years of work experience

 - Community college that trains a priority job
 - Equity gaps based on age, gender, and race/ethnicity
 - Gender percentage in Labor Force
 - o 45% Female
 - o 55% Male
 - Gender in Community College
 - o 54% Female
 - o 46% Male
 - Age % in Labor Force
 - o 16% Female, 50% Male (16-24 years of age)
 - o 38% Female, 31% Male (25-39 years of age)
