- 4. Updated Employer Engagement Graphic: K. McMackin shared the updated Employer Engagement Graphic. Changes have been made based on input from the CE Deans, Associate Deans, and other participants in the regional employer engagement process. The graphic highlights regional stakeholders, industry sectors, the five economies, and college and employer outcomes. The graphic is still in draft form and has not been released publically.
- 5. Perkins V: A. Perman reported that there has been a regional approach to working on Perkins V. This approach has included regional workshops and the development of a regional guide. The CCCCO released its own <u>Perkins V guide</u> on February 10, 2022. The materials developed by the region are being updated to reflect this new information. Additionally, the Center of Excellence for Labor Market Research (CoE) developed a Comprehensive Regional Needs Assessment (CRNA). T. Ngo Bartel shared a <u>flyer for upcoming Perkins V workshops</u> with the registration link included. The same workshops will be held on February 23, 2022 from 2:00 pm to 4:00 pm and February 25, 2022 from 9:00 am to 11:00 am. Additionally, the CoE's CRNA report will be released on February 16, 2022.
