Exhibit 2: Percentage of Total Number of Online Job Postings by 21st Century Employability Skill San Diego County (2010 & 2019)

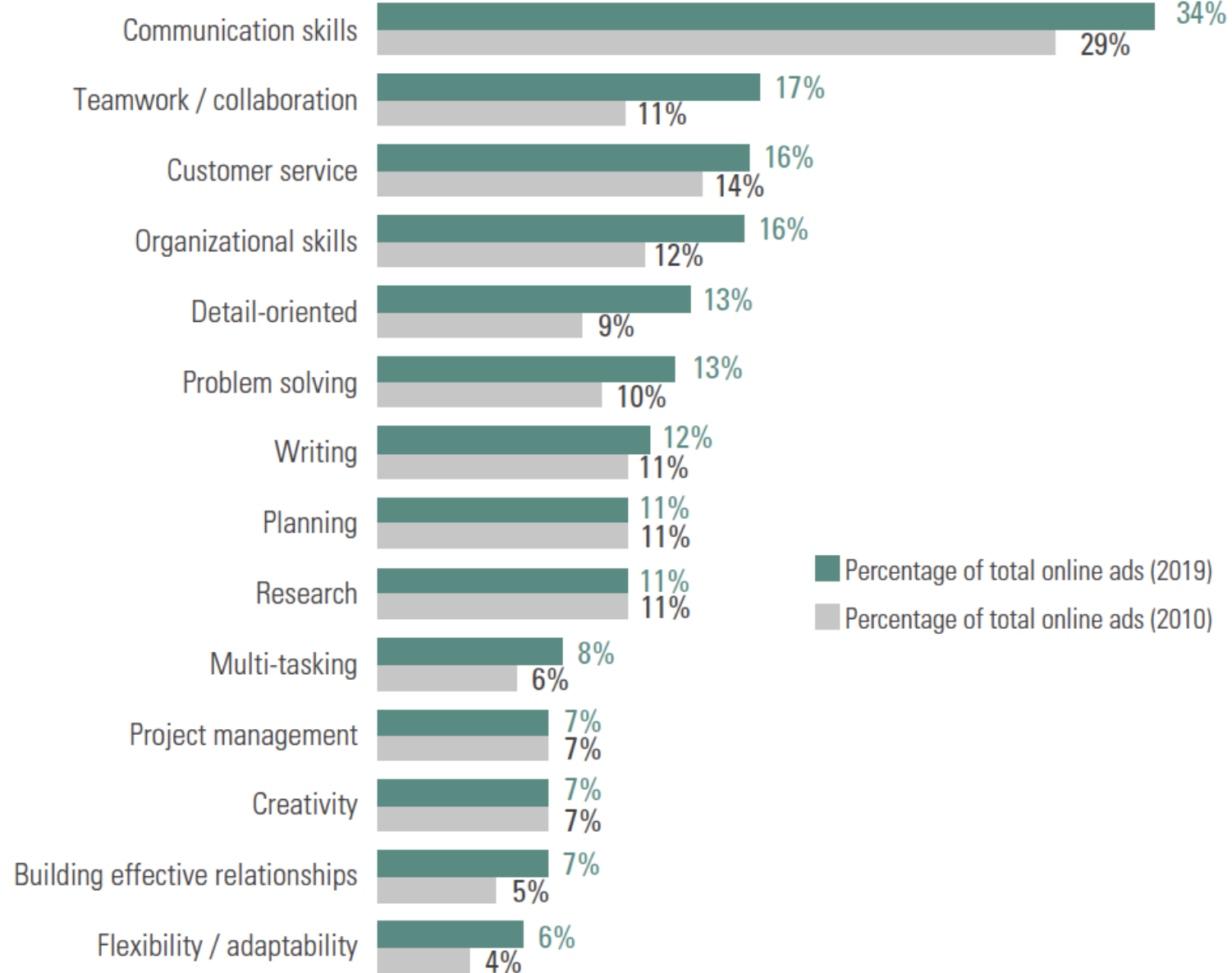
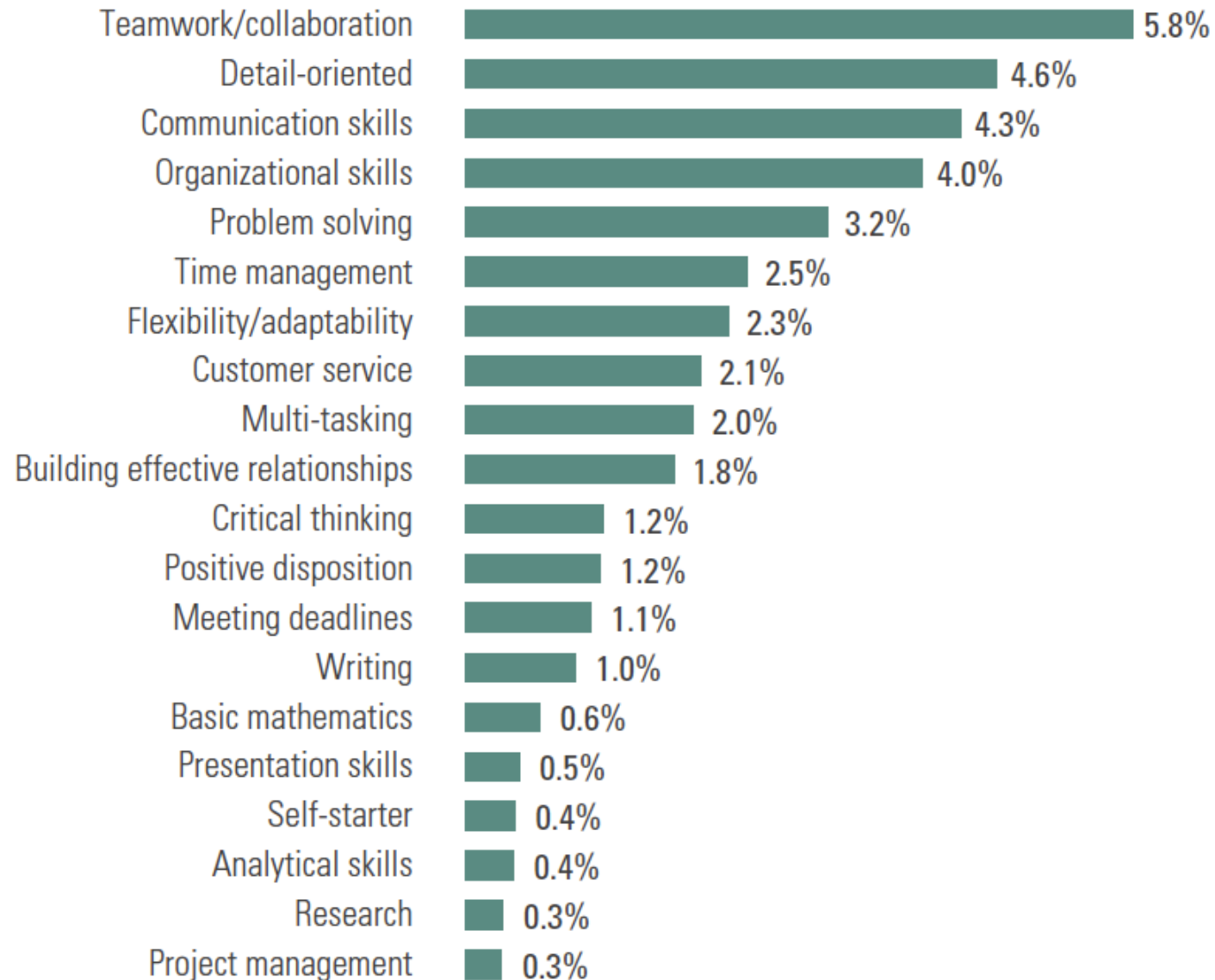


Exhibit 3: Difference in Percentage Makeup of Total Online Job Postings in San Diego County Between 2010 and 2019 by 21st Century Employability Skill

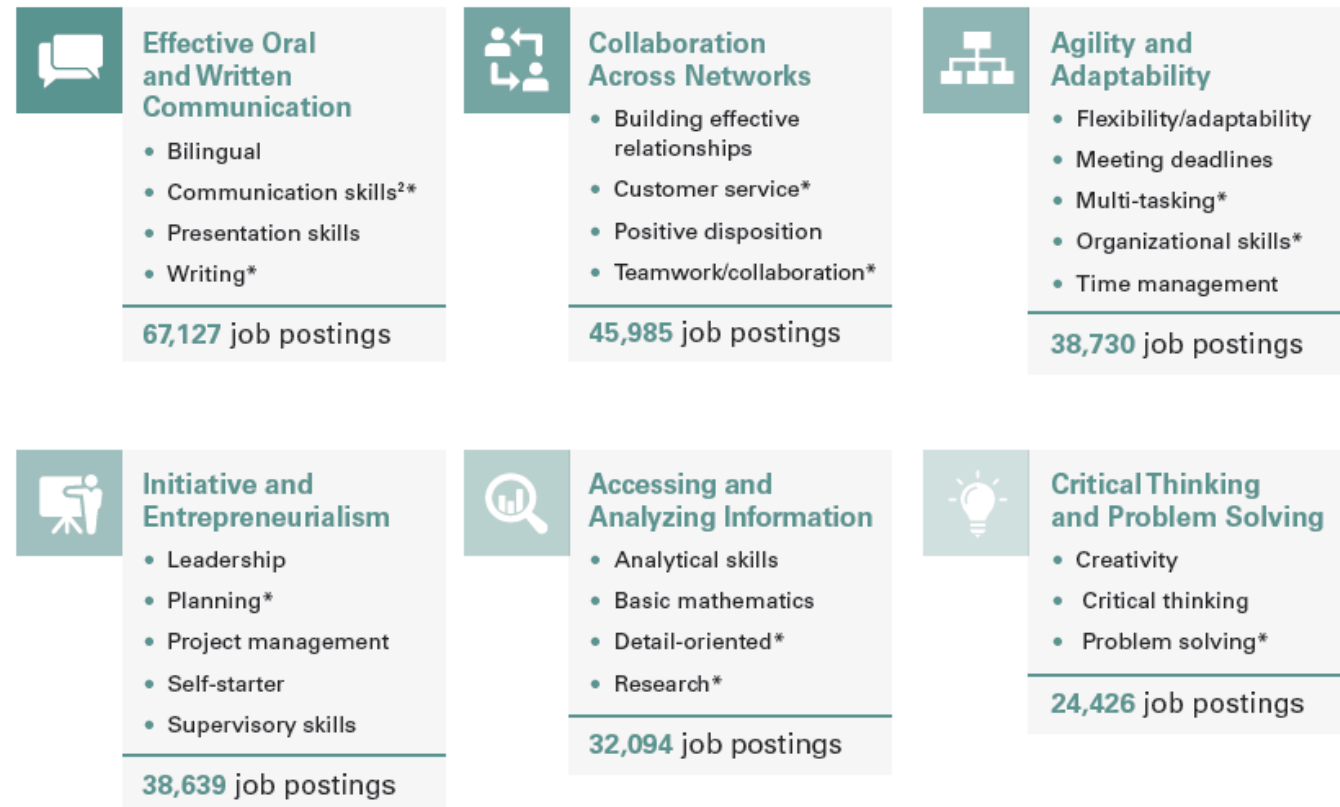

A "21st century employability skill" is any skill or quality that can be classified as a personality trait or habit. These skills have also been referred to as "soft skills," "baseline skills," "essential skills," "foundational skills," and "emotional intelligence."

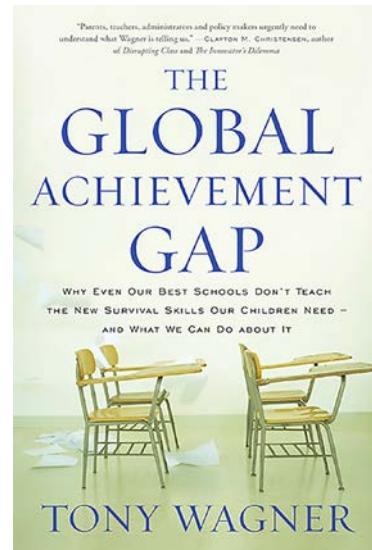

Scenario: You want to share this information with students, but how do you explain what these skills are?



Effective Oral and Written Communication: LinkedIn Learning (2020) identified “communication” as one of the top three skills in the workplace.¹⁰ Technology allows companies to have virtual teams not only throughout the United States, but all over the world. Therefore, the “ability to express one’s views clearly . . . and to communicate effectively across cultures” is highly valued by employers.¹¹

Collaboration Across Networks: As virtual and global collaboration increases, employees must be able to work with people of different generations and backgrounds. Workers who can trust, understand, and appreciate diverse cultures will have a competitive advantage over others.¹²

Agility and Adaptability: Employers need workers who are resilient, adaptable, and flexible to change. Technology intensifies the rate of change in the workplace, provides an overwhelming amount of data, and increases complexity of problems that companies face each day.¹³

Initiative and Entrepreneurialism: “Leadership and management” is also one of the top three skills in the workplace identified by LinkedIn Learning (2020). As companies become “less hierarchical and more reciprocal and relational,” workers need to be able to take initiative and lead by influence, not by force.¹⁴

Accessing and Analyzing Information: LinkedIn Learning (2020) explains that “as companies continue to collect and analyze more data than ever before, they need people who can help interpret and take action on the data to drive growth.”¹⁵

Critical Thinking and Problem Solving: “Creative problem solving and design thinking” is also one of the top three skills identified by LinkedIn Learning (2020). According to Wagner (2008), “The habit of asking good questions was most frequently mentioned as an essential component of critical-thinking and problem-solving skills.”¹⁶ Employees will have to work together to figure out solutions to cross-departmental problems; management will not simply provide the answers.¹⁷

21 st Century Employability Skill	Definition
Analytical skills	Analytical skill is the ability to visualize, articulate, conceptualize or solve both complex and uncomplicated problems by making decisions that are sensible given the available information.
Basic mathematics	Mathematics is the study of topics such as quantity (numbers), structure, space, and change.
Bilingual	Bilingual means involving or using two languages.
Building effective relationships	Building relationships is about your ability to identify and initiate working relationships and to develop and maintain them in a way that is of mutual benefit to both yourself and the other party. Good relationships are the key to getting things done and are essential when your success is dependent on others.
Communication skills	The ability to convey information to another effectively and efficiently. This skill includes verbal/oral communication and written communication.
Creativity	Mental characteristic that allows a person to think outside of the box, which results in innovative or different approaches to a particular task.
Critical thinking	Experience objectively examining assumptions (adopted rules of thumb) underlying current beliefs to assess their correctness and legitimacy, and thus to validate or invalidate business beliefs.
Customer service	Experience working with customers to ensure their satisfaction with a product or service.

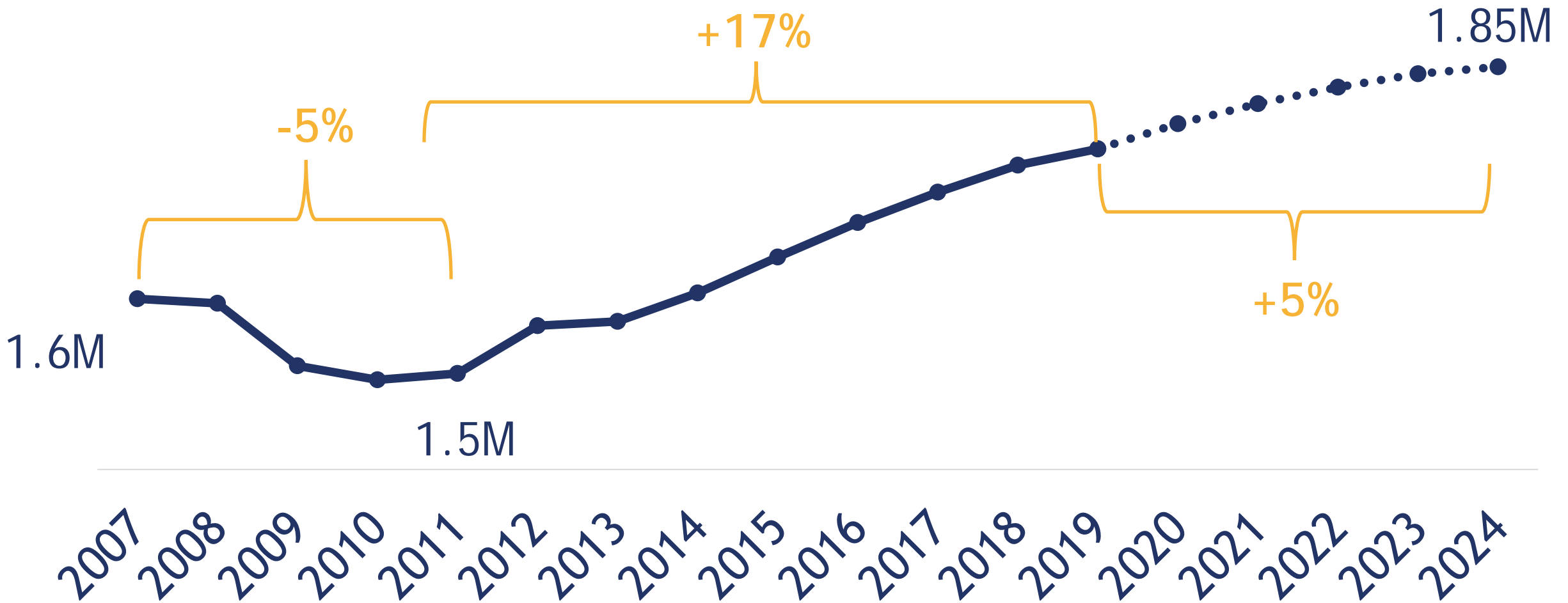

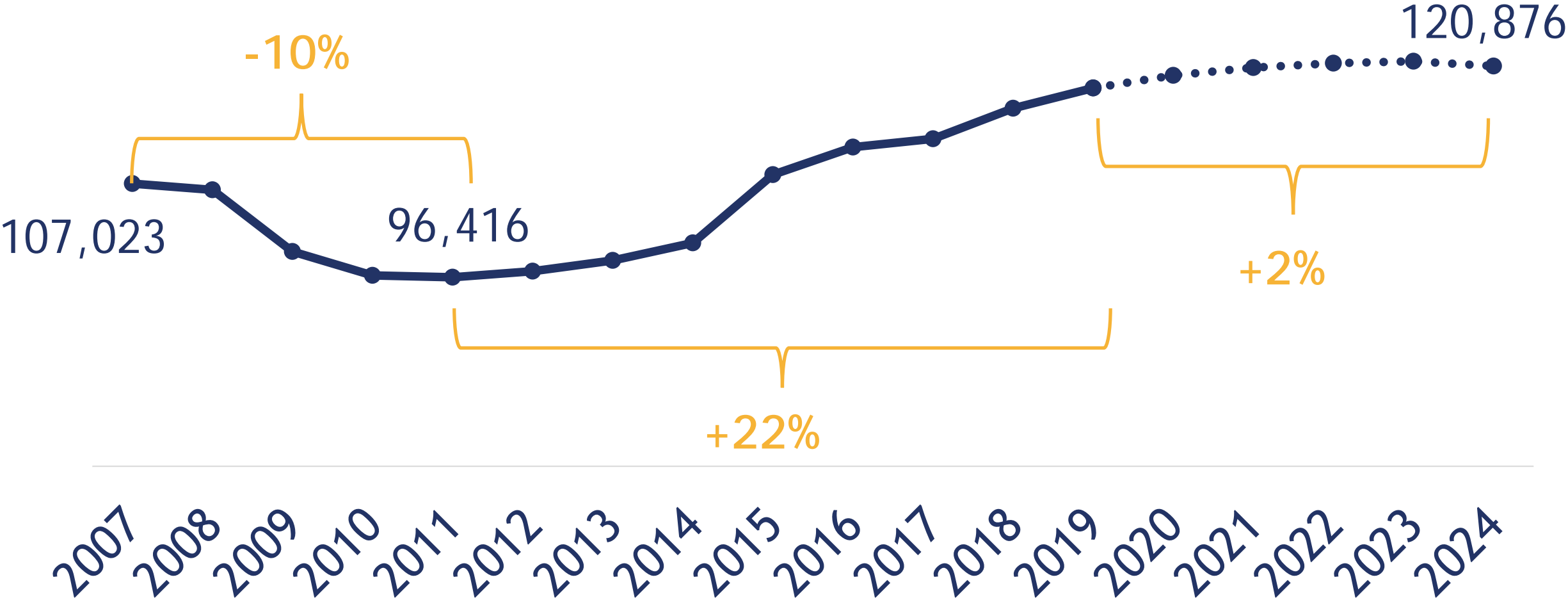


Total Jobs (Employment) in San Diego County



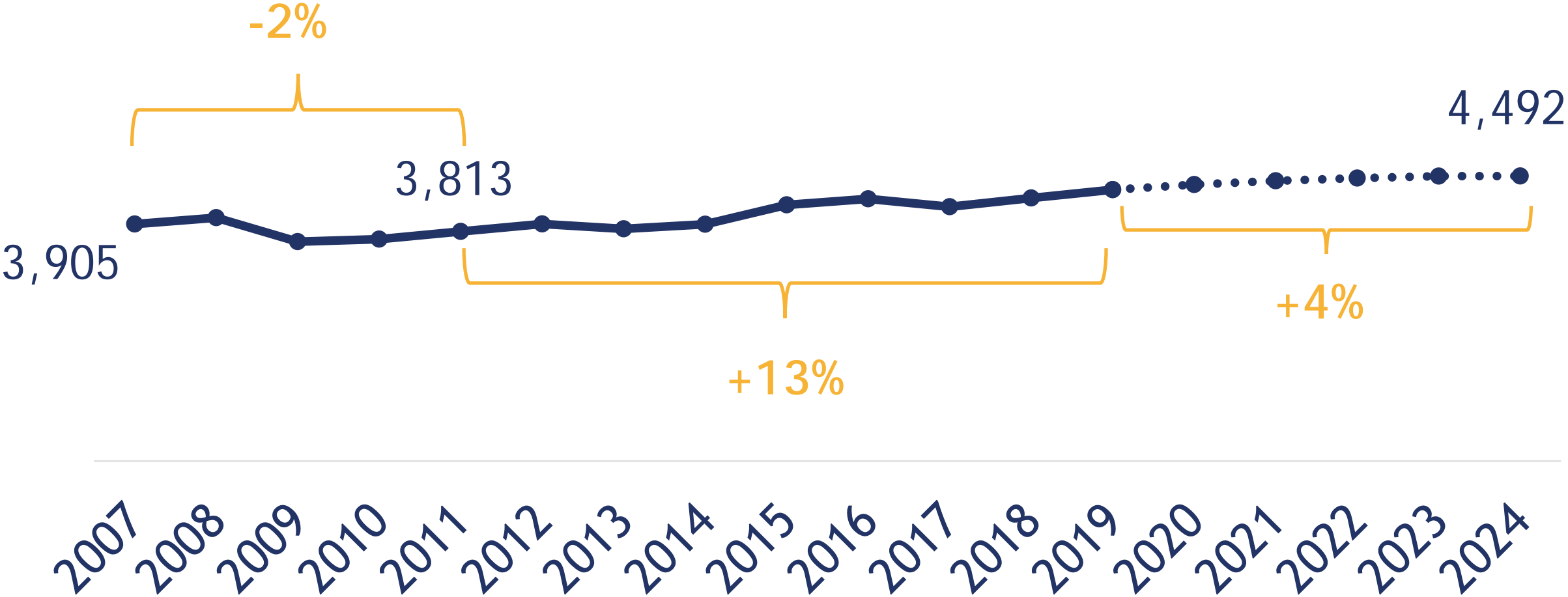

Workshops for Warriors provides training in welding, machining and manufacturing to veterans and service members transitioning out of the military.

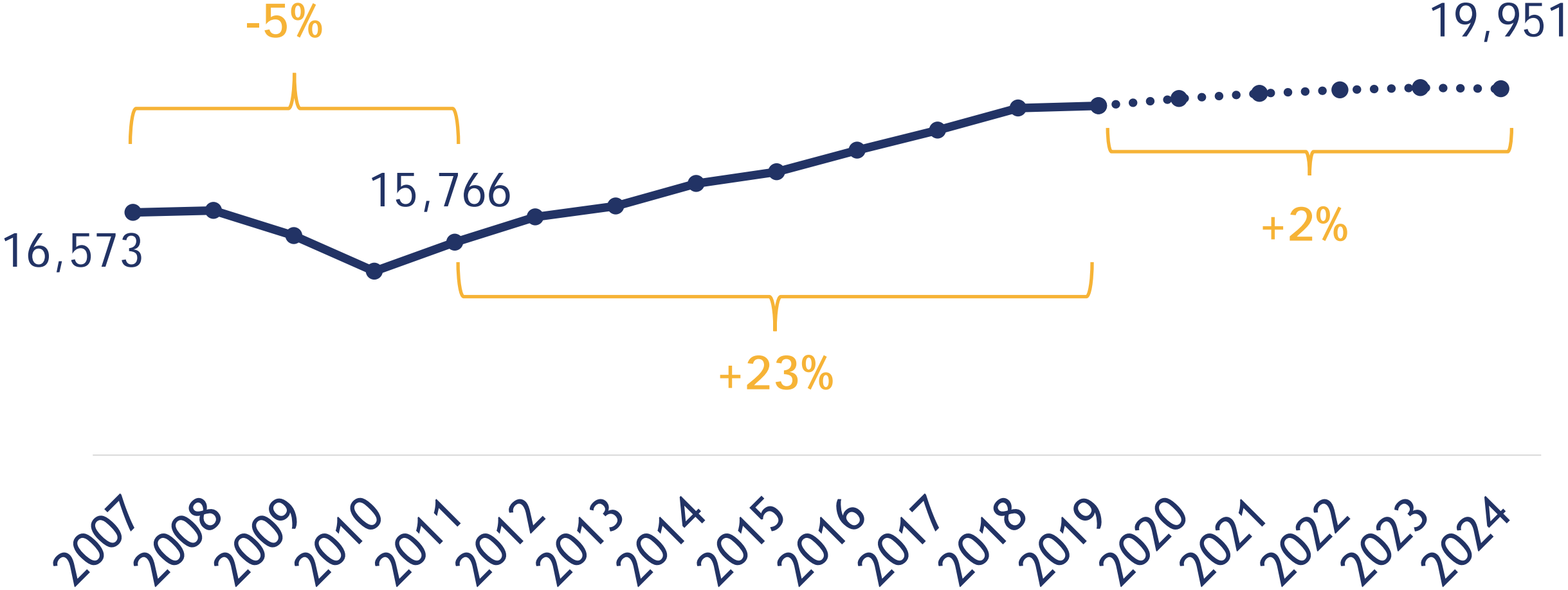

Cust Service Reps - Total Jobs in Life Sciences



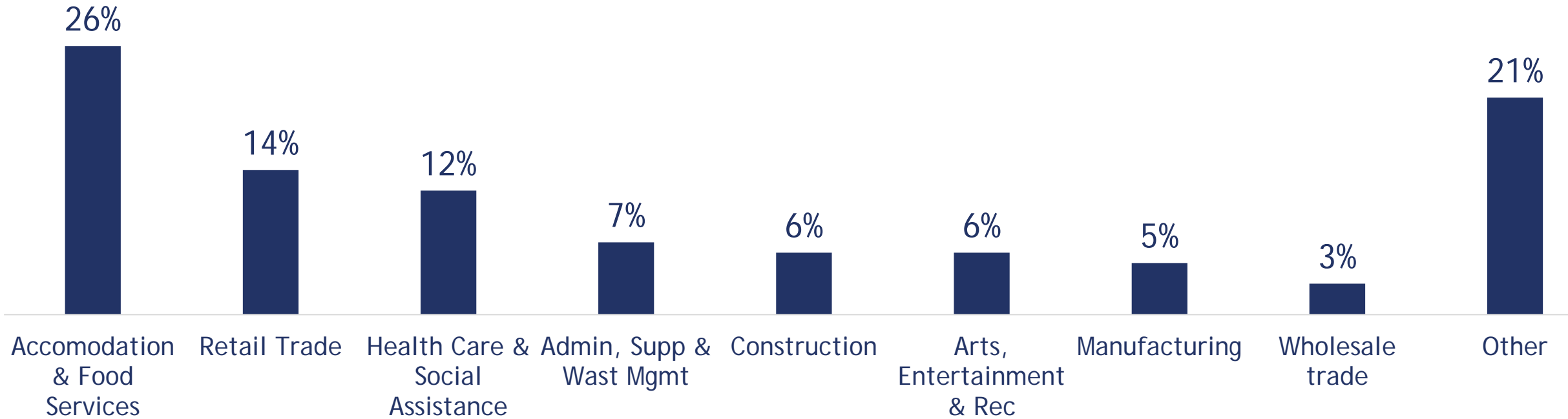
