


- ITEL completers will be able to access up to \$300 in implementation grants (per person)

SCOPE OF WORK

Through the COE, which is hosted at MiraCosta College, the Regional Consortium will provide the Recipient with the following temporary CTE/CE research support:

- 1. Provide access to a CTE/CE Research Expert for the duration of the MOU
- Oversee the onboarding and training of Research Expert in topics <u>outside</u> of Recipient's programs, processes, policies, and procedures
- 3. Provide necessary work equipment (laptop, monitor, etc.)
- 4. Manage HR-related needs (performance evaluation, time off, benefits, etc.)
- Help reach a consensus between the Recipient's CTE/CE and institutional research offices and make a final determination in the event that the two offices are unable to reach a consensus regarding the Research Expert's responsibilities, projects, and tasks
