 - The Center of Excellence commissioned this study to understand prospective and current students' experiences with accessing student support services online
 - The survey asked participants to locate the student support services landing page and information about academic counseling, career center services, and student health services.

 - ITEL completers will be able to access up to \$300 in implementation grants (per person)
 - Includes completers from 1st and 2nd cohorts
 - Grant applicants will be asked to show proof of implementation efforts

 - o T. Ngo-Bartel shared the suggested timeline for Regional Institutes and Research Funds
 - J. Edwards shared the USC and UC Program Finder Tool
 - o Tool stemmed from AB 927
 - Authorized the Board Governor of the California Community Colleges (CCC) to extend the operation of the statewide baccalaureate degree pilot program indefinitely
 - o Documentation regarding unmet workforce needs
 - 5.C.i Employers are having difficulty filling positions that require a baccalaureate degree
 - 5.C.ii Employers are willing to pay baccalaureate degree holders more than those with a related associate degree or no postsecondary degree
 - 5.C.iii Employers have a preference for candidates with the proposed baccalaureate degree
 - o J. Edwards provided instruction on how to utilize the Program Finder Tool
 - $\circ~$ J. Edwards shared the discussions at the 3.2.2023 Baccalaureate Conference
 - Some discussions on maybe switching to 30 applications, once a year. Instead of twice a year with 15 applications
 - Associate degree is needed no exceptions to apply for B.S. if the program does not already have an Associates, then the application will be thrown out
 - Still to be considered, giving an opportunity to those that don't have a bachelor's degree vs. those campuses that already have one program. No language to limit how many applications a district or college can submit
 - Is your campus ready to support a 4 year program
 - Update college mission statement
