G. Behrouzian gave a presentation on assessing student satisfaction and sense of belonging.

Community College Attrition Rates:

- · Attrition rates are consistently higher at community colleges than those of four-year institutes
- Non-traditional characteristics of community college students contribute to this trend:
 - o Older
 - o Commuter
 - o Part-time
- Even less likely to persist are first-generation, ethnic/racial minority, and low-income students

Additional variables include level of commitment to academic goals, background, environmental variables, academic outcomes, and psychological outcomes.

Sense of Belonging:

- Belonging is described as a student's perceived social support on campus. Support may come from other students, faculty, and/or administrators and staff. Success for students is more likely when students feel directed, focused, nurtured, engaged, connected, and valued.
- When sense of belonging is lacking, it can lead to withdrawal from learning activities and decreased motivation to persist
- What can be done to help improve student belonging in the classroom?
 - Normalize challenges to belonging
 - Plan to check in with students
 - Provide wise feedback
 - Celebrate mistakes
 - Assess sense of belonging
 - Survey
 - Daily activities
