

Process Demonstration for Work-based Learning

The intent of this presentation is to demonstrate established work-based learning processes developed at each college. It is important to establish functionality of WBL processes before receiving any additional funding from the region.

- 1. Colleges will receive a series of prompts/scenarios to demonstrate the processes they have developed for their campuses
 - a. Each map or significant step in the map may have its own scenario
- 2. The demonstration should be a high level, visual representation of the processes
 - a. Colleges may choose any technology they are comfortable with to display processes via Zoom, including PowerPoint, Canvas, Google docs, Zoom Whiteboard, etc.
 - b. Be prepared to highlight key stages of the process.
 - c. How would you explain the process to someone who does not have your level of experience or background, a new faculty or someone who is taking over your position?
- 3. Colleges should use the diagnostic questions provided to highlight key points in their presentations
- 4. The purpose of this demonstration is to show how steps are being taken to establish a framework that is transparent and understood by staff, faculty and students
- 5. The intent is for colleges to share these presentations with each other, possibly at the WG4 Meeting, COP, or other designated forum for feedback and questions
