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Why Use Data in Pathway Navigation Practices?

- Creates and maintains focus on student equity and equitable practices
- Creates an opportunity to connect with campus researchers
- Identifies promising strategies for implementation to address areas of improvement
- Reveals challenges to institutionalizing practices
- Supports messaging around the change process in progress
- Monitors progress and impact
- Builds momentum



Data Use for Equity in PN Practices

- Reflect on accomplishments as we transition from 3-year investment to future years
- 4. Explore the types of data that could be shared to track outcomes as part of the next RFA
