Why Use Data in Pathway Navigation Practices?

- Creates and maintains focus on student equity and equitable practices
- Creates an opportunity to connect with campus researchers
- Identifies promising strategies for implementation to address areas of improvement
- Reveals challenges to institutionalizing practices
- Supports messaging around the change process in progress
- Monitors progress and impact
- Builds momentum

Data Use for Equity in PN Practices

1. Continue commitment to equity and equitable outcomes
2. Engage CoP members in substantive dialogue around data use
3. Reflect on accomplishments as we transition from 3-year investment to future years
4. Explore the types of data that could be shared to track outcomes as part of the next RFA

Pathway Navigation Goals and Success Indicators

Goals

- **Intake:** Increase student enrollment in pathways and student utilization of needed academic and other support services available at their college.
- **Orientation:** Increase the number of students entering college with knowledge of pathways and services, while facilitating students' integration into college life.
- **Career planning:** Increase the number of students' knowledgeable about their own interests and careers goals, to support effective education planning and long-term success.

EQUITY LENS

DATA WILL TELL US:

1. Who is the focus?
2. When and where do we focus?
3. What are desired outcomes?
4. Is progress being made?
5. How do we measure progress over time?

Indicators of Success

- Adoption of comprehensive student intake form and # students completing intake process
- Creation a differentiated orientation program and # students participating
- # students completing career exploration activities before education planning
