Pre-enrollment Outreach & Engagement

- Relationship building and connections with students you're focusing on
- Outreach/In-reach
- Focus on initial contacts and touch points (e.g., peer ambassadors, initial advising/counseling connections, first year experience teams)
- Comprehensive intake process and form
- Pathway guidance (introduction)
- Career exploration



Differentiated Orientation

- Beyond online vs. in-person focus
- Differentiated orientation based on
 - Pathway
 - Background
 - Needs
 - Interests
 - Education and career goals
- Pathway information
- Continued connection with student mentors, ambassadors and learning communities of student groups/populations



Ongoing & Integrated Career and Ed Planning

- Career assessments (initial and ongoing)
- Consistent, coordinated advising and counseling
- Career plan before ed plan
- Career exploration and WBL experiences
- Career preparation orientation courses
- Transfer plans linked to career and ed plans


