How would you feel about organizing them around building all the elements of at least one pathway (Outreach, Alignment, Acceleration), documenting the process as a model for future pathway development? Meeting 1 (Sept) – Welcome back, reflection from last year and agreed upon Goals, Recommendations for CC's going through the approval process (Deans, ROC, SDICCCA), share annual plan, advise about delay in Program Finder release (Sept 22)

Meeting 2 (Oct) – Results of FY 22/23 Options Survey – DEI lens, Launch of Program Finder tool, activity around usage of tool, Focus on Information Technologies (ICT) & Digital Media, one of the 4 priority pathways identified by the COE.

Meeting 3 (Nov) – Deep dive into ICT pathway – look at data, propose next steps for spring

Meeting 4 (Feb) – Focus on pathway Outreach components

Meeting 5 (Mar) – Focus on pathway Alignment components

Meeting 6 (Apr) – Focus on pathway Acceleration components
