- T. Ngo Bartel shared
 - COE will be releasing an E-news announcing that CTE research experts funded through the SDIRC is the biggest investment from a regional consortium into research compared to any other region. There will be an introduction of what research experts to do, profiles of each of those research experts, and some testimonials of how they've helped their colleges.
 - Chancellor's announcement that Perkins V is changing the qualifying list of occupations.
 - Statewide COE created a spreadsheet to identify those qualifying applications, and removed a lot of occupations that qualify for Perkins V
 - J. Edwards of the COE created a spreadsheet showing which are appropriate for San Diego and Imperial.
 - Only 245 out of 800 jobs are eligible with the minimum wage of \$28.75
 - D. Brown stated that she will share any concerns with the Chancellor's office around the changes in Perkins
 - Faculty Institute RFA will be released soon.
 - Applications will be released through a GroupTrail link
 - Two important requests in the RFA
 - Colleges to do evaluations on the programs of the faculty member that participated in the Faculty Institute to see if there were any changes pre and post Faculty Institute.
 - If college has a Institutional Research Expert, the RFA will fund your current CTE, 1.5 FTE or through a research expert through the COE. If college has an extenuating circumstance, there will be consultation meetings with the Regional Consortium to further discuss.
