1. Welcome & Introductions

- D. Brown shared that N. Roe is now the Dean of Career Technical and Educational Services at Palomar College

5. L. Wisdom shared K-12 SWP

- K12 SWP Round 7
 - Proposed tentative date for RFA is 8.19.24. Proposed date to submit by is 10.11.24
 - Letter of support from colleges are required and must be signed by a CTE Dean. [Link to Letter of Support Template](#)
 - L. Wisdom will be providing a variety of engagement sessions in September for information on the application and Nova system. As well as providing an AI literacy presentation in the near future
- K12 SWP + CC K12SWP Collaboration
 - In preparation for RFA, it is encouraged for colleges to meet with K12 partners to align their work with regional and college priorities
- Pathway Coordinators
 - Liz Cardenas who was servicing the Imperial Valley Community College service area has taken on a new position. Will update once a replacement has been chosen.
 - Donnie Tenorio who was servicing the San Diego Community College District will be leaving mid-summer. No replacement has been found yet. Will provide updates as they come.
 - The rest of the Pathway Coordinators from last year will still be in place this year
- Articulation
 - Will continue to hold Articulation Community of Practices in the Fall and the Spring
 - Working on collecting data and sharing data. Ideally will be easier in the future. Primary partners right now are Southwestern College and Sweetwater Union High School District.

- If there is anything around the process procedures of articulation that the colleges would like to make more efficient and effective please reach out to L. Wisdom. This will be the last time offering the support for 2024-2025 school year
- Will be meeting with Chancellor's office later this month. If there are any talking points that would like to be conveyed during this meeting, please reach out to L.Wisdom
- Dual Enrollment
 - Still continuing the data work. Still working on prior years data
 - Hoping to try to collect the next round of Dual Enrollment data earlier than previous years. Looking to send out requests this fall.
 - Will be going to the Data Innovation Committee meeting to explore with CTE researchers how to get student level data
 - Reminder colleges in the region have been working on Dual Enrollment strategic plans

6. D. Brown and J. Lewis shared updates with the SWP Budget – Local/Regional

- \$65M has been taken off the top and we have received a new allocations for 2024-2025
 - \$5M is for the United Domestic Workers (UDW) project
 - \$60M will be for Nursing
- \$60M will be taken off the top for the next 5 years
 - 22.8% decrease (~\$2M) for the region
 - Given the unspent funds the region should be able to cover the budget reduction.
 - The Implementation Committee has discussed which regional funds can be reduced or discontinued to maintain the projects and supports the colleges.
- On 8.29.24 the Chancellor's Office will hold an Annual Budget Workshop for 2024 that will discuss SWP and Nursing Programs. D. Brown will send information out
