- K-12 SWP Updates:
  - o Intent to award (Round 7) has been announced.

- Dual Enrollment and AB 1244:
  - L. Wisdom discussed <u>new legislation</u> (AB 1244), which allows K-12 partners to seek dual enrollment partnerships with other colleges if their primary community college does not respond within 60 days.
  - o CCCCO AB 1244 guidance memo
- Credit by Exam and Articulation:
  - Concerns with the UC system's acceptance of credit by exam and articulation, noting a need for clearer communication and understanding between educational systems.

- Governor's proposed budget for fiscal year 2026 will be released later today at 10am
- Feedback is requested on the regional monitoring staffing structure as the Workforce and Economic Development Division prepares for new leadership.
  - A new Dean and visiting administrator will join in February, prompting a reorganization of programs and staff assignments.
  - o Staff prefer focusing on single programs due to workload concern, changes could lead to delays.
  - o Input on the potential impact of these changes is sought.

- D. Brown met with Allied Health and Nursing leads to discuss an AI ESL support software (PACE).
  - The AI software supports English language learners by helping with content comprehension and verbal communication skills, including pronunciation feedback.
