CTE Researcher: Recap

- 1. Based on feedback from the deans/associate deans, the region provided funding for each college to have a local CTE researchers. However, some colleges were unable to hire a CTE researcher and asked if the region could hire them on their behalf.
- 2. COE hired the CTE researchers and established an MOU with each of the colleges that requested a CTE researcher. The original MOU was for two years (7/1/23- 6/30/25).
 - a. 7/1/23 6/30/24 @ \$499,396
 - b. 7/1/24 6/30/25 @ \$681,366
- 3. Colleges/districts that received CTE researchers: City, CCE, IVC, Mesa, MiraCosta, Miramar, SDCCD, and Southwestern. (No Cuyamaca, Grossmont or Palomar)
- 4. The region had carryover funds the following year and was able to provide another year of funding for the CTE researchers (7/1/25 6/30/26 @ \$562,670)

CTE Researcher: Challenges

- 1. We do not have the funding to continue with the current Round 10 RFA projects.
- 2. The college would prefer we (region/COE) hire the researcher on the colleges' behalf (due to college hiring freezes, wrong side of the 50% law, etc.)
- 3. COE doesn't have the capacity to continue supervising the CTE researchers.



CTE Researcher: Options

- 1. Discontinue the CTE Researchers as of June 30, 2026.
- 2. Reduce Round 10 RFAs and create a CTE Researcher RFA, with direct funding to the colleges.
- 3. Reduce Round 10 RFAs and the region hires the CTE Researchers on the colleges' behalf.
- 4. Wait to see if \$60M is returned to SWP in the 2026-2027 Budget. Prioritize funding for local CTE researchers with back-fill in Round 11.



Round 10 RFAs

- Accelerating Career Education Outcomes Investments (\$80,000/college)
- Capacity Building: Adult Learners Research (\$50,000/college)
- Job Placement Case Manager (\$175,000/college)
- Sector Investments (\$125,000/college)
- Work-based Learning Coordinator (\$80,000/college
